WHAT IS GDPR?

By 25th May 2018, all organizations that handle the data of EU citizens will be required to comply with a single set of rules about data governance, regardless of where the organization is located. The introduction of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) will dramatically change the way in which data is stored, shared and moved. The legislation will give individuals greater rights and control over their data by way of consent as well as the power to access, rectify or erase information held and the right to be informed.

With severe non-compliance penalties of up to the greater of EUR20 million or 4% of worldwide turnover, the GDPR will make organizations more accountable for their approach to data, and the changes must be given appropriate consideration.

Businesses need to make sure they are technically and organizationally ready for the legislation before it comes into force on 25th May 2018. That might sound like more than enough time to prepare, but getting your house in order is not an overnight task.
